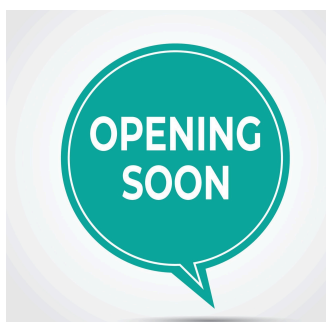




Dear Colleagues,

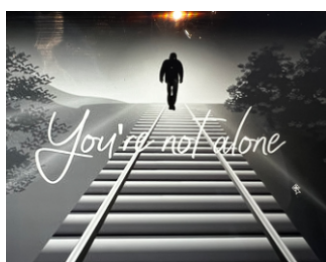


All places were filled early last year, so please do not delay. Interviews for the first tranche of candidates will take place - in person - in Dublin on Friday, May 16th.
